The CGC Test is open to all qualified dogs, regardless of pedigree.

The CGC Test is comprised of the following parts:

- 1) Accepting a friendly stranger who approaches to talk
- 2) Sitting politely for petting by a stranger
- 3) Accepting a brief exam and grooming
- 4) Walking on a loose leash
- 5) Walking nicely through a crowd
- 6) Sit, down & stay with owner 20 feet away
- 7) Coming when called on a long line with the owner 10 feet away
- 8) Sit for greeting by another handler & dog
- 9) Reacting appropriately to distractions
- 10) Three minute wait with tester while owner out of sight

CGC Test Rules:

- 1) Handlers must bring current Rabies Certificate (*tags not acceptable*)
- 2) No pinch collars or head halters allowed (*buckle or choke collars made of nylon, leather or chain acceptable*)
- 3) Dogs must be on leash at all times
- 4) See additional rules & recommendations on back of this page!
