

## Rally Obedience Classes with Diana Doolittle

**Session Dates: Friday, Feb. 24 to April 7 (skip Mar. 10)**

### **6:00 PM Beginning / Novice (6 week session)**

This class is perfect for handlers and dogs with little to no Rally experience. During the first two weeks of the session, Diana will teach, review and refine the signs (exercises) used in Rally Novice. Signs will be put together for short sequences. The last four weeks of the session will be Rally Novice courses (two rings/courses each week) with instructor feedback. Pre-requisite: Dogs must have good on-leash control and know basic obedience commands. No aggressive dogs. \$175 (eligible for multi-class discounts)

### **7:15 PM Advanced / Excellent (6 week session)**

This class is for handlers and dogs who have completed the Rally Beginning/Novice class and/or handlers who have previous experience and know how to execute the Novice signs. During the first two weeks of this session Diana will teach, review and refine the signs used in both Advanced and Excellent. Signs will be put together for short sequences. The last four weeks of the session will be Rally Advanced/Excellent courses (two rings/courses each week) with instructor feedback. Pre-requisite: Rally Novice experience. No aggressive dogs. \$175 (eligible for multi-class discounts)

### **8:15 PM Layered Rally Novice/Advanced/Excellent Courses For Practice (Drop-in only)**

If you don't need instruction, and just want the opportunity to run your dog through courses, this is for you. Depending on the attendance each week, Diana will set up one or two rings/courses for different levels. Students will take turns going through the courses. When everyone has had several turns, the practice will end (so be sure to arrive at 8:15 if you plan to attend). Cost for current Family Dog students: \$10 per week / Cost for non-students: \$20 / week. Please pay in cash at the door.
